Federal Agencies in the Courthouse

Federal agencies write state court procedure across the spectrum—from those relating to jurisdiction, pleadings, joinder, and class actions to evidentiary privileges, protective orders in discovery, and remedies. Relying on data gathered through the National Center for State Courts, this Article shows how this unexamined form of federal regulation enlists state courts as regulatory partners in a novel form of policymaking outside the traditional constraints of our federalism and separation of powers. Agencies' work inside state courthouses, however, is not only lawful, but can enhance access-to-justice and promote robust regulatory experimentation across state lines.
